Gypsy Sally's Produce Palace is a 3 acre farm, with a focus on open pollinated and heirloom vegetables, herbs, and flowers; the unusual, the beautiful, and the delicious!

KNOW WHERE YOUR FOOD COMES FROM!

The idea of a Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) was started by Japanese mothers during the 1960's, concerned about the safety of imported food and the loss of agricultural land to urbanization. They created a system called "teikei", which literally translates to "putting the farmer's face on food."

SUPPORT LOCAL FARMS

CSA programs create a direct, mutually beneficial relationship between consumers and farmers on a local level. CSA members help to cover a farm's operation costs by purchasing a share of the harvest. In return, CSA members receive a share of fresh and healthy produce, herbs, and a newsletter full of inspiring recipes each week of the growing season.

THE HARVEST*

Some of the seasonal offerings you will receive:

Vegetables: spinach, asian greens, kale, chard, collards, lettuce, kohlrabi, cilantro, arugula, parsley, chives, cucumbers, summer squash, tomatoes, tomatillos, basil, peppers, eggplant, green beans, melons, broccoli raab, cabbage, winter squash, carrots, beets, celery leaf, onions, potatoes, and herbs

Fruit: strawberries, apricots, cherries, blueberries, peaches, plums, apples, and pears

*Gypsy Sally grows a variety of crops to ensure a diverse harvest each week. However Mother Nature does have a hand in surplus and deficiency of particular crops. If you get too much of something, we hope you can preserve it or share with friends. Although we strive for diversity if there is a crop failure, it is a risk the farmer and the consumer share together.

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VEGETABLE HARVEST SHARES

Large Vegetable Share: A large share typically feeds a family of 2 to 4 people. June 6th to October 14th (21 weeks @ \$22/ wk = \$462)

Small Vegetable Share: A small share generally feeds 1-2 people at least 3 times a week. June 6th to October 14th (21 weeks @ \$16/ wk = \$336)

FRUIT HARVEST SHARE

Enjoy fresh locally grown fruits each week from a variety of small farms in the Milton Freewater & Walla Walla area. (\$6 x 21 wks = \$126)

FLOWERS

A fresh cut, bouquet of colorful flowers each week from West End Farm. (\$8 x 21wks = \$168)

THE PICK UP

A reminder will be sent a week before the season begins with the time and location of the pick-up.

If you miss a pick-up: please contact me by the afternoon of the next day, and we will make arrangements for your pick-up. All Shares left unclaimed by the designated time will be donated to the local food bank.

If you will be out of town: it is your responsibility to find someone to pick up your share. Upon initial payment, if you know you will miss part of the season, we can deduct the cost of the shares you will not receive.

VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

A limited number of reduced share prices in exchange for farm work will be offered this season. Commitment and dependability are very important. Contact me for more information.
